LO label	Learning outcomes description
PSO01	Argue facts and theoretical findings in the field of health care
PSO02	Link the physiological and pathophysiological functions of the organism connecting the condition and behavior of healthy and sick individuals with their physical and social environment
PSO03	Interpret disease characteristics which are important in assessing the health status of patients and providing health care
PSO04	Apply basic and advanced life support procedures based on an assessment of vital parameters and applicable guidelines
